Gulliver: a project of inter-culture between festival

Three festivals of cultural study, Leggendometropolitano in Cagliari, Pistoia - Dialoghi sull'uomo and Il senso del ridicolo in Livorno, they have structured themselves this year with Gulliver, the intercultural exchange project that gives to volunteers the opportunity to travel, know a new city, make new friends, gain experience and meet great writers and thinkers, both Italian and international.



The new editions of Leggendometropolitano (June 2 to 5) and Pistoia - Dialoghi sull'uomo (27 to 29 May), just about to start, will open this type of cultural exchange for the training of young people. Among the candidates that have arrived for Cagliari three university students from Pistoia were selected, they will fly to Sardinia to work alongside volunteers of Cagliari.

"The initiative of the exchange of volunteers - says the founder and director of the Dialoghi sull'uomo, Giulia Cogoli - certainly represents an exciting opportunity confrontation for the youngsters, some kind of inter-culture between festivals. In 2017, it will be us to be the hosts of volunteers from Cagliari in Pistoia". "I am sure that will be a positive experience, which will set in motion new energy and will open up new horizons, and I hope that other festivals will follow our example," says Saverio Gaeta, Director of Leggendometropolitano.

In this context it is also started the collaboration with the festival on humor Il senso del ridicolo, directed by Stefano Bartezzaghi, scheduled in Livorno from 23rd to 25th of September.
